RESULTS

The scale 1 survey evaluates your position on the hierarchist-egalitarian scale. You are <u>either</u> a hierarchist or egalitarian. To calculate, you must tally your answers according to numbers associated to your answers (e.g. "strongly agree" = 1).

However, for some questions (#'s 2, 4, 6, 7, 11, 12, 14), numbers are reversed (i.e. 1 = 5, 2 = 4, 3 = 3, 4 = 2 and 5 = 1).

Once results have been tallied, you can place yourself on the hierarchist-egalitarian scale according to the following parameters:

- If tally <35, you are hierarchist
- If tally >35, you are **egalitarian**

RESULTS

The scale 2 survey evaluates your position on the individualist-communitarian scale. You are <u>either</u> an individualist or communitarian. To calculate, you must tally your answers according to numbers associated to your answers (e.g. "strongly agree" = 1).

However, for some questions (#'s 2, 4, 6, 7, 11), numbers are reversed (i.e. 1 = 5, 2 = 4, 3 = 3, 4 = 2 and 5 = 1).

Once results have been tallied, you can place yourself on the hierarchist-egalitarian scale according to the following parameters:

- If tally <42.5, you are **individualist**
- If tally >42.5, you are **communitarian**

Cultural worldview (overall result)

Once both scales 1 and 2 are complete, you will have one of four cultural worldview profiles:

- Egalitarian-individualist;
- Egalitarian-communitarian;
- Hierarchist-individualist; or
- Hierarchist-communitarian.
